The following mediums are accepted: ceramics, drawing, fiber, furniture, glass, jewelry, acrylic, oil, watercolor, pastel, sculpture, wood, mixed media, collage, leather, photography, and printmaking. If you work in a medium not listed above, please contact us for consideration.

Our plans for the day include around 30 artists selling their work, delicious home-baked items from local bakers, live music, wine tasting, craft beer, fresh-picked local produce, and local food vendors.
