## SLUG RESISTANT

Slug resistant identifies plants that have a denser, thicker leaf. These hostas are described as having "good substance". Slugs usually prefer the more tender plants.

## SUN TOLERANT

A rule of thumb is: Gold or green hostas can tolerate more sun than blue hostas. Blue hostas have the best coloration in more heavily shaded areas of the garden. These hostas have held up well in "Full Sun" (four hours + afternoon sun), without excessive TLC. Please take this list as helpful, but not factual, as hostas generally are shade loving.
