Once you receive your hostas in the mail......

We ship our hostas to you bareroot. The hostas are removed from the pot (or dug from the ground), excess dirt is shaken off, and the roots are wrapped in plastic to hold in the moisture. Orders are generally shipped on a Monday or Tuesday so that they will be sure not to sit in a post office over the weekend. Spring orders often have little foliage growth on them. Later orders will have foliage, although we may have trimmed off some of it.

Plant your hostas as soon as possible after receiving them. If you can't get them planted right away, keep the roots moist. Drip a little water into the wrapped root ball, or unwrap the hostas, add a moist paper towel, and rewrap them. If, after you have planted your new hostas, any of the existing leaves wilt, just cut them off so that the plants can concentrate on making new roots rather than trying to support leaves that they can't support anyway.
