## Daylilies: (NAME OF HYBRIDIZER AND YEAR DIRECTLY FOLLOW NAME OF DAYLILY)

**Raspberry Suede** (Blaney 1998) 28 inches-M-D-TET-5 inches; rich, very deep raspberry red flowers have a smooth, velvety texture like suede and a small green throat; quite sunfast for such a dark----- 15.00

## Grasses:

**Festuca glauca 'Blue Whiskers'** (Blue Fescue) bright silvery blue leaves form a fully rounded, robust clump; yellow-green flowers appear on 18-22 inch scapes in early summer and age to tan; foliage reaches 10-12 inches; full sun; Zone 4----- 12.99

**Hakonechloa macra 'Albovariegata'** (Hakone Grass) deep green and creamy white variegated foliage; taller and more vigorous than other selections; 24-30 inches; best in partial shade in moist, but well-drained, soil; Zone 5 ----- 14.99

**Miscanthus sinensis 'Autumn Anthem'** (Maiden Grass) selected for its heavy flower production and perfect habit; feathery, cream plumes cover the top 2/3 of the plant; 5-6 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 5 ----- 14.99

**Schizachyrium scoparium 'Blue Paradise'** (Little Bluestem) upright and columnar habit stays upright all season; silvery blue leaves in summer turn a deep wine color in the fall; 36-42 inches; full sun; Zone 3 ----- 14.99

## Hostas:

**Size:** After the name of each hosta, we have listed the size of the plant, based upon the approximate diameter of the plant at maturity. Although some hostas grow more upright than others, height will generally correspond to diameter (i.e., the larger the diameter, the taller the plant).

**Diameter** of mature plant:

[D] = Dwarf, up to 6"                      [S] = Small, 8"-16"                      [MS] = Medium-Small, 18"-24"                      [M] = Medium, 26"-36"  
 [ML] = Medium-Large, 36"-40"                      [L] = Large, 40"-48"                      [XL] = Extra-Large, over 48"

**Flower Color:** After the description of each hosta, we have listed the color of the flower:

(L) = Lavender                      (P) = Purple                      (W) = White                      (NW) = Near white                      (B) = Blue

**Envy** [M] bright green centers with showy yellow margins that become white in late summer; somewhat upright habit (L)- 20.00

**First Blush** [MS] spring foliage will start to "blush" red from the tip of the leaf down toward the base; red color holds until temperatures reach into the 90s; red petioles extend into the leaf blade (L) ----- 40.00

**Munchkin Fire** [D] short and narrow leaves hold their bright yellow color all season long; vigorous grower (L) ----- 18.00

**One Last Dance** [ML] this sport of 'Dancing Queen' has dark green leaves with very wide, intense yellow margins that become chartreuse by midsummer; irregular, wavy edges create a feathery look (L) ----- 18.00

<b>Petticoat Junction</b> [M] waxy, broad leafed blue hosta with ruffled margins; very appealing look with tight ruffles and twisted leaf tips (L)-----	20.00
<b>Stan the Man</b> [M] blue leaves with a bicolor cream margin and some puckering (L) -----	25.00
<b>Sugar Daddy</b> [ML] a sport of 'Big Daddy' with large cupped blue-green leaves with white streaks and margins; heavy substance and slug resistant (W)-----	18.00
<b>Sun Mouse</b> [D] has a similar leaf shape and performance to 'Blue Mouse Ears', but with brilliant yellow leaves; a little shorter and wider than 'Blue Mouse Ears' (L)-----	15.00
<b>Sunset Grooves</b> [MS] a sport of 'Rainforest Sunrise' with thick, round, puckered yellow leaves with wide dark green margins; forms a low mound about a foot tall with a two foot spread (L) -----	18.00

## Perennials:

<b>Alcea rosea Halo Series 'Cerise'</b> (Hollyhock) large, cerise pink flowers with a deep purple halo; 5-6 feet; full sun; per the breeder, the halo series are Zone 3 hardy perennials-----	9.99
<b>Amsonia tabernaemontana 'Storm Cloud'</b> (Blue Star) new stems emerge near-black in Spring; dark green leaves have silver veining; light blue, star-shaped flowers cover this wide mound for many weeks in late spring and early summer; 24-30 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
<b>Aquilegia 'Blue Jay'</b> (Columbine) large, upward-facing blue and white flowers in late spring and early summer; 20-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia canadensis 'Little Lanterns'</b> (Columbine) easy to grow dwarf selection with tons of vibrant red and yellow pendant flowers in late spring; 12-18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Baptisia 'Lavender Stardust'</b> (False Indigo) 18 inch lilac purple flower spikes rise above the full, wide clump of foliage; 36- 42 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Campanula carpatica 'Rapido Blue'</b> (Bellflower) violet blue, cup shaped flowers bloom up to 4 weeks earlier than the 'Clips' varieties; 5-7 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Campanula glomerata 'Genti White'</b> (Clustered Bellflower) clustered, bell-shaped, pure white flowers atop dark green foliage; compact habit and long bloom season from late spring through mid summer; 18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Coreopsis 'Enchanted Eve'</b> (Tickseed) butter yellow blooms with a soft red eye are incredibly long blooming; disease-free green foliage stays nice all season; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	9.99
<b>Coreopsis 'Starlight'</b> (Tickseed) large white flowers with a burgundy eye are produced all season; compact, low mound of highly disease resistant foliage; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	9.99
<b>Dianthus Fruit Punch® 'Black Cherry Frost'</b> (Pinks) semi-double, velvety red flowers have a fine, serrated, near white edge; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
<b>Dianthus Fruit Punch® 'Spiked Punch'</b> (Pinks) incredibly vibrant, fuchsia pink, double flowers have deep red eyes and heavily serrated petals; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
<b>Dianthus 'Paint the Town Fuchsia'</b> (Pinks) fuchsia flowers with lavender centers completely cover the blue-green foliage during peak bloom; prized for bright flower color and increased heat tolerance; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
<b>Dianthus 'Paint the Town Magenta'</b> (Pinks) magenta pink flowers completely cover the blue-green foliage during peak bloom; prized for bright flower color and increased heat tolerance; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
<b>Echinacea Double Scoop Mandarin</b> (Coneflower) large, fluorescent orange pom-pom flowers with strong stems; flowers age to dark rosy pink tones; 18-22 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Echinacea Sombrero® Adobe Orange</b> (Coneflower) intense orange flowers and a matching orange cone; one of the best orange Echinacea to date; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Epimedium grandiflorum 'Rose Queen'</b> (Barrenwort) a mound of dark green leaves bears sprays of delicate bright-pink flowers in mid to late spring; excellent for edging or groundcover; drought tolerant and long-lived once established; 8-10 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 4-----	16.99
<b>Hakonechloa macra 'Albovariegata'</b> (Japanese Forest Grass) long, narrow rich green leaves have slim bands of creamy white running their length; prefers moist, well-drained soil; best grown in bright, light shade; 24-30 inches; Zone 5-----	16.99
<b>Helleborus × nigercors 'Snow Love'</b> (Lenten Rose) large, outward-facing white blooms are held well above the foliage, aging to a greenish tinge; blooms late winter through mid spring; dark green, deer-resistant foliage; 14-16 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 4 -----	19.99
<b>Helleborus ballardiae 'HGC Pink Frost'</b> (Lenten Rose) burgundy buds open to 2-3 inch, two-tone pink and white, outward-facing flowers from late January into March; a vigorous, heavily budded selection; 12-15 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 5-----	19.99

<b>Helleborus 'Confetti Cake'</b> (Lenten Rose) double white flowers with burgundy speckling toward the center of the petals; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Helleborus ericsmithii Candy Love</b> (Lenten Rose) dark green deer-resistant foliage is topped with huge, 3.5 inch wide pink-tinged white flowers which age to chocolate; blooms late winter to mid spring; 15 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 3 -----	19.99
<b>Helleborus 'First Dance'</b> (Lenten Rose) 2 inch blooms are bright yellow to yellow with a maroon picotee edge and veining; blooms early to mid spring; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Helleborus 'Flower Girl'</b> (Lenten Rose) double blush to light pink flowers in early to mid spring; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Helleborus 'Paris in Pink'</b> (Lenten Rose) 3-4 inch, single light to medium pink flowers in early to mid spring; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Helleborus 'Sandy Shores'</b> (Lenten Rose) 3 inch, single pale apricot flowers with a rosy pink color on the backs; blooms early to mid spring; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Helleborus x ericsmithii 'HGC Champion'</b> (Lenten Rose) rosy buds open to large, creamy white blooms from January to March; a highly prolific bloomer with front-facing flowers; dark green foliage is deer resistant; 15-18 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 4-----	19.99
<b>Helleborus x hybridus 'Berry Swirl'</b> (Lenten Rose) double blooms in shades ranging from pink to deep rose bloom from late winter to mid spring; thick, glossy deer-resistant foliage; 12-15 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 5 -----	19.99
<b>Heuchera 'Black Pearl'</b> (Coral Bells) the new standard in black Heuchera; dense mound of shiny, jet black leaves with scalloped, ruffled edges and rosy purple undersides; white flowers; 8-10 inches; sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Heuchera Dolce® 'Appletini'</b> (Coral Bells) lime green leaves have a silver overlay; dark rose red stems hold ruby red flowers starting in early summer; reblooms occasionally into fall; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 ---	14.99
<b>Heuchera Dolce® 'Silver Gumdrops'</b> (Coral Bells) a smaller scale Heuchera with silver, iridescent leaves and a semi-glossy finish; vibrant pink flowers in summer; 6-8 inches tall x 14-16 inch spread; partial sun to shade; Zn 4 -	14.99
<b>Heuchera 'Electric Plum'</b> (Coral Bells) near black new leaves lighten to an intense purple with dramatic black veining; bright fuchsia pink flowers in summer; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Heuchera 'Pretty Pistachio'</b> (Coral Bells) chartreuse foliage in spring mellows to lime green in summer; huge clusters of medium pink flowers appear all summer long; 8-10 inches; best in filtered sun or afternoon shade; Zone 4 ----	14.99
<b>Heuchera villosa 'Mega Caramel'</b> (Coral Bells) like 'Caramel' but much bigger!; large, caramel foliage with pink-purple undersides; cream flowers in mid-summer; 18-20 inches tall with a spread of 20-28 inches; needs afternoon shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Heucherella 'Galactica'</b> (Foamy Bells) large, dissected silvery green leaves with deep colored veining; forms a very full, rounded clump; partial sun to shade; 8-10 inches; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Heucherella 'Pumpkin Spice'</b> (Foamy Bells) bronze red leaves with deep mahogany centers emerge in late spring and hold the color well into early summer; 8-10 inches tall x 18-22 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Heucherella 'Red Rover'</b> (Foamy Bells) deeply lobed leaves emerge coppery red and have burgundy red centers; foliage mellows to olive green later in the season; 6-8 inches tall x 18-20 inch spread; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 ---	14.99
<b>Hibiscus Summerific® 'Ballet Slippers' #3</b> (Rose Mallow) huge 7 inch, ruffled flowers are white with a deep red eye and blush pink edges; upright habit with an extremely high bud count; 4 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	24.99
<b>Iris siberica 'Concord Crush'</b> (Siberian Iris) large, 6 inch double blue flowers have a long bloom season and attract hummingbirds; 28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Leucanthemum superbum 'Spoonful of Sugar'</b> (Shasta Daisy) enormous 4 inch, creamy white flowers have two rows of very long petals; compact, dome-like habit; 16-18 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	12.99
<b>Lilium o. 'Sunny Keys'</b> (Oriental Lily) vibrant, dark pink-red blooms with a white edge; 16-18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Lobelia speciosa Fan® Salmon</b> (Cardinal Flower) striking, salmon-pink flowers on strong burgundy stems; compact upright habit with green foliage maturing to bronze purple towards fall; 24 inches; prefers moist soil and afternoon shade; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Papaver nudicaule Pulcinella Rose</b> (Iceland Poppy) warm rose flowers bloom all summer; 12-15 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -	9.99
<b>Penstemon 'Blackbeard'</b> (Beardtongue) dark purple flower stems hold lilac purple flowers with white flaring tubes; dark eggplant purple foliage; strictly upright habit; 28-34 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
<b>Perovskia atriplicifolia 'Rocketman'</b> (Russian Sage) a narrower, upright vase-shaped habit and relatively short stature set this new Perovskia apart; lavender blue flowers on grey-green aromatic foliage; 30-36 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Phlox 'Fashionably Early Crystal'</b> (Hybrid Phlox) pure white flowers with a faint light purple eye begin blooming in early summer; dark green, thick foliage has exceptional mildew resistance; 28-32 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99

<b>Phlox 'Fashionably Early Flamingo'</b> (Hybrid Phlox) light lavender pink flowers begin blooming in early summer and boast a long season of color; thick, dark green foliage is mildew resistant; 30-36 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Sanguisorba 'Little Angel'</b> (Burnet) tiny deep green leaves with creamy white margins form a dense petite clump; oval-shaped rosy red flower panicles pop out of the top of the plant on green stems; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
<b>Sedoro 'Blue Elf'</b> (Stonecrop) a Sedum and Orostachys hybrid; steel-blue tufted rosettes of foliage are smothered in highly fragrant, tight clusters of dark pink flowers in late summer; 3 inches tall x 15 inches wide; full sun; Zone 4 ---	12.99
<b>Sedum 'Frosted Fire'</b> (Stonecrop) light green leaves with creamy yellow, serrated margins form a dense, upright mound; rosy flower heads in late summer and fall; 12-15 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	14.99
<b>Sedum Sunsparkler® 'Wildfire'</b> (Stonecrop) this striking introduction has ruby-red foliage edged in pink; long-lasting pink flower clusters appear in late summer; 6 inches tall x 15 inches wide; full sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
<b>Tradescantia 'Charlotte's Web'</b> (Spiderwort) a gold foliage Spiderwort that doesn't burn in the sun!; chartreuse foliage transitions to gold with more sun exposure; soft blue flowers cover plant in summer; 16-18 inches; sun to shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
<b>Veronica 'Blue Skywalker'</b> (Spike Speedwell) lavender blue flower spikes cover the top half of this upright, dense mound of dark green foliage throughout the summer; 28-30 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Veronica Magic Show® 'Pink Potion'</b> (Spike Speedwell) baby pink flowers cover this low, rounded mound from early to mid summer; 14-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
<b>Veronica 'Perfectly Picasso'</b> (Spike Speedwell) white buds open to medium pink flowers, creating a bicolor look; healthy green foliage on a beautifully rounded habit; 22-26 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Veronica 'Royal Rembrandt'</b> (Spike Speedwell) violet purple flower spikes bloom throughout the summer and will rebloom when cut back; 18-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Viola cornuta 'Halo Violet'</b> (Violet) extra large deep violet-blue flowers with yellow centers and whiskers; blooms late spring to mid summer with some re-bloom in the fall; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Yucca filamentosa 'Excalibur'</b> (Adam's Needle) a uniform, compact habit of spiky blue-green to grey-green leaves lined with curly white filaments; sturdy spikes of white flowers in summer; foliage grows to 18-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99

<b>Abies veitchii 'Heddergott' #6</b> (Dwarf Veitch Fir) glossy green needles with white undersides on a low, spreading plant; sun to part shade; garden size 4' tall x 6' wide; Zone 4 -----	199.99
<b>Acer palmatum dissectum 'Red Dragon' #6</b> (Japanese Laceleaf Maple) the new nursery standard; dark purple-maroon foliage color throughout the hot summer months on a vigorous, well-branched tree; Zone 5 -----	149.99
<b>Acer palmatum 'Sango Kaku' #6</b> (Japanese Maple) widely known as the Coral Bark Maple because of its coral red bark; yellow-orange leaves in spring turn soft green, then yellow in fall; part shade; 15' tall; Zone 5 -----	149.99
<b>Acer palmatum 'Sherwood Flame' #6</b> (Japanese Maple) small garden tree with rounded, formal form; red foliage in spring and early summer, turning reddish green in late summer and cherry red in fall; 15' tall x 12' wide; Zone 5-----	129.99
<b>Acer palmatum 'Tobiosho' #6</b> (Japanese Maple) green foliage on a broad, upright habit; foliage turns yellow, then orange, then brilliant scarlet in fall; part shade; up to 20' tall and wide; Zone 5 -----	129.99
<b>Acer trun. x plat. Ruby Sunset® #7</b> (Hybrid Maple) compact tree with elegant, dark green, glossy foliage, turning dark red in fall; 25' tall and 20' wide, perfect for smaller sites; Zone 4 -----	179.99
<b>Berberis thunbergii Toscana® #3</b> (Barberry) showy red foliage emerges in spring with a fine yellow margin; red darkens to burgundy in fall; sun; arching shrub 3-5' tall; spread 2-4'; Zone 4 -----	39.99
<b>Betula jacquemontii 'Tickle Creek' #6</b> (Dwarf White Birch) lacy, deeply cut leaves on a slow growing dwarf birch; white twigs turn to copper in second season; trunk and branches turn white with age; sun; 6' tall x 4' wide; Zone 4 --	199.99
<b>Callicarpa Pearl Glam® #2</b> (Beautyberry) attractive purple foliage all summer; white flowers in spring; large, violet berries in fall; sun; 4-5' tall and wide; Zone 5 -----	29.99
<b>Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Iseli Green' #3</b> (Hinoki Cypress) one of the faster growing and larger Hinokis; forms a distinctive tree with gently cupped sprays on graceful, spreading branches; irregular form makes each unique; 20' tall x 15' wide; Zone 5 -----	69.99
<b>Diervilla Kodiak® Red #3</b> (Bush Honeysuckle) red colored foliage in spring and fall; yellow spring flowers; durable, drought tolerant and deer resistant; sun or shade; 3-4' tall and wide; Zone 4-----	39.99
<b>Ginkgo biloba Presidential Gold® #10</b> (Ginkgo) large shade tree with fan shaped leaves of medium green, turning bright yellow in fall; sun; 50' tall; spread 40'; Zone 4-----	199.99

<b>Gymnocladus dioicus Espresso® #10</b> (Kentucky Coffee Tree) bluish-green, doubly compound leaves on an oval to vase shaped tree with arching branches; turns yellow in fall; sun to part shade; 50' tall; spread 35'; Zone 4 -----	199.99
<b>Hibiscus syriacus Azurri Blue Satin® #3</b> (Rose of Sharon) new seedless selection with large, single, rich royal blue flowers; sun to part shade; 8-12' tall; spread 6-8'; Zone 5-----	39.99
<b>Hibiscus syriacus Lil' Kim® Red #3</b> (Dwarf Rose of Sharon) miniature Rose of Sharon; long lasting deep rose red flowers with a showy red eye; sun to part shade; 3-4' tall; Zone 5 -----	39.99
<b>Hibiscus syriacus 'Summer Ruffle' #3</b> (Variegated Rose of Sharon) blue-green and creamy white variegated foliage with dark pink to lavender flowers in summer; nice dwarf at 3-4'; Zone 5 -----	49.99
<b>Hydrangea arborescens Incrediball® Blush #3</b> (Smooth Hydrangea) big, bodacious, blush pink blooms on sturdy stems; blooms turn to an attractive green color as they age; part shade; 3-5' tall; Zone 4 -----	49.99
<b>Hydrangea arborescens Invincibelle® Ruby #3</b> (Smooth Hydrangea) dark red buds open to two-toned combination of bright ruby red and silvery pink flowers; dark green foliage and strong stems; reblooms until frost; best in part shade; 3' tall; Zone 4 -----	49.99
<b>Hydrangea macrophylla Let's Dance®Blue Jangles® #3</b> (Big Leaf Hydrangea) compact, dependable rebloomer with pink or blue flowers, depending on soil acidity; blooms on old and new wood; 2-3' tall; Zone 5 -----	49.99
<b>Hydrangea serrata Tuff Stuff® Red #2</b> (Mountain Hydrangea) green and red blooms mature to intense reddish-pink, lacecap flowers, blooming on both old and new wood; excellent reloomer; part shade; 2-3' tall and wide; Zn 5	29.99
<b>Juniperus squamata 'Blue Carpet' #3</b> (Blue Carpet Juniper) pointed blue needles on a low, spreading form; excellent ground cover for sunny areas; Zone 3 -----	39.99
<b>Magnolia soulangeana Mercury® #15</b> (Saucer Magnolia) deep pink buds open to lavender pink flowers nearly a month later than other saucer types; upright pyramid 25' and 15' wide; Zone 5 -----	199.99
<b>Metasequoia g. 'Shirmann's Nordlicht' #6</b> (North Light Dawn Redwood) delightful dwarf selection; somewhat globose; responds to shearing; variegation may be yellow in sun, creamy in shade; 6' tall x 4' wide; Zone 5-----	179.99
<b>Picea abies 'Blaze' #6</b> (Red tipped Norway Spruce) similar to 'Rubra Spicata' but with brighter red tips in spring; sun; grows around 30' tall and 10' wide; Zone 3 -----	149.99
<b>Picea glauca 'North Star' #6</b> (White Spruce) extremely tough, sturdy, compact White Spruce; forms classic pyramid; sun; 12' tall and 6' wide in 10 years; Zone 3 -----	139.99
<b>Picea obovata 'Arctos' #20</b> (Siberian Spruce) unique bluish green color on a tough, durable pyramidal tree; moderate growth rate; sun; 10' tall x 8' wide in 10 years; Zone 2-----	279.99
<b>Picea pungens 'Avatar' #6</b> (Blue Spruce) lush, powder blue puffs of foliage in spring; distinctive tiered branching pattern; sun; slower grower; 20' tall and 15' wide in 10 years; Zone 2 -----	149.99

<b>Rosa 'All the Rage' #2</b> (Shrub Rose) delightful, multi-colored rose; coral buds swirl open to apricot blossoms with luminous yellow centers; blooms all season; sun; 3-4' tall and wide; Zone 4-----	29.99

### TREES IN LINER POTS

All of these plants are great to use in troughs and fairy gardens. Trim them back if they start to get too large, or pop them out and let them grow to full size elsewhere in your gardens.

**Berberis thunbergii 'Golden Torch'** (Golden Barberry) similar in habit and size to the popular 'Helmond Pillar', but with bright yellow foliage throughout the season; sun; 6' tall; spread 3'; Zone 4 ----- 17.99

**Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Nana Lutea'** (Golden Hinoki Cypress) golden yellow new growth on globose plant that becomes more upright with age; best in afternoon shade; up to 4' tall and 3' wide; Zone 5 ----- 17.99

**Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Sunny Swirl'** (Golden Hinoki Cypress) unusual, stiff, contorted branches with mahogany red bark contrast with twisted, threadlike, golden foliage; part shade; 8' tall; 6' spread; Zone 5 ----- 17.99

### Vines:

**Clematis Cassis®** 4 inch blooms are deep plum with an interesting mottled pattern; long bloom time of about 4 months from June to September; grows to 6-10 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 3 ----- 24.99

**Clematis 'Elsa Spath'** 6 inch blue flowers with red anthers cover this vine in early summer and again in late summer; grows 8-12 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 2----- 19.99

**Clematis 'H.F. Young'** deep lavender flowers bloom in May and June and again in September; grows 6-8 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 2----- 19.99

**Clematis Rosalie®** flowers start off a deep-two-toned rose; as flowers keep coming and some start to fade to lavender pink, 'Rosalie' takes on a vast array of pink shades; blooms June through September; grows to 7 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 5----- 19.99
