<b>Berberis thunbergii 'Admiration' #3</b> (Barberry) exciting dwarf form selected for its show stopping orange-red foliage with yellow margins; turns brilliant red in fall; 12-18 inches tall and 18-24 inches wide; sun; Zone 4 -----	39.99
<b>Berberis thunbergii 'Bagatelle' #3</b> (Barberry) even smaller than 'Crimson Pygmy'; dark brick red leaves turn brighter red in autumn before falling; sun; 14-16 inches; Zone 4 -----	39.99
