<b>Achillea millefolium 'Red Velvet'</b> (Yarrow) large clusters of ruby-red, non-fading flowers with creamy white centers bloom all summer; 24-30 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Achillea millefolium 'Sunny Seduction'</b> (Yarrow) buttery yellow flowers bloom slightly earlier than others in summer; more compact and uniform than 'Moonshine'; 24-28 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Achillea 'Moonshine'</b> (Yarrow) aromatic foliage with sulfur yellow flowers in early summer; sun; 18-24 inches; Zone 3----	9.99
<b>Achillea 'Saucy Seduction'</b> (Yarrow) uniform canopies of rose-pink flowers atop shorter and more compact foliage; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Aegopodium podagraria 'Variegatum'</b> (Snow on the Mountain) rapid spreading ground cover with green and white leaves; white flowers from late May until late June; will grow in poor soil, sun or shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Agapanthus 'Blue Yonder'</b> (Lily of the Nile, African Lily) large clusters of blue flowers above rich green foliage in summer; clumping habit; 24-30 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	14.99
<b>Agastache 'Blue Fortune'</b> (Anise Hyssop) lavender blue bottlebrush-like flowers from mid summer to early fall; this long bloomer provides color late in the season; 24-36 inches; sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Ajuga reptans 'Black Scallop'</b> (Bugleweed) smaller-scale groundcover with glossy, near-black, scalloped leaves; stays compact; blue flowers; sun or shade; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Ajuga reptans 'Burgundy Glow'</b> (Bugleweed) variegated foliage of burgundy, creamy white and green which gives a vivid tricolor effect; blue flowers on 6 inch spikes; sun or shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Alcea 'Fiesta Time'</b> (Hollyhock) relatively short spikes of double, cherry pink, fringed blossoms beginning in midsummer; 36 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Alcea rosea Halo Series 'Cerise'</b> (Hollyhock) large, cerise pink flowers with a deep purple halo; 5-6 feet; full sun; per the breeder, the halo series are Zone 3 hardy perennials-----	9.99
* <b>Alcea rosea Halo Series 'Lavender'</b> (Hollyhock) large, lavender flowers with a pink halo; 5-6 feet; full sun; per the breeder, the halo series are Zone 3 hardy perennials-----	9.99
<b>Alchemilla mollis</b> (Lady's Mantle) an easy to grow evergreen ground cover with rounded, lobed leaves; tiny yellowish green flowers in June stand 18 inches tall; sun to shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Allium 'Millenium'</b> (Ornamental Onion) a picture perfect, compact, upright clump of glossy green leaves is covered in a profusion of 2 inch bright rosy purple flower clusters in mid to late summer; 15-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 5-----	9.99
<b>Allium senescens 'Blue Eddy'</b> (Ornamental Onion) pinwheel-like rosettes of blue-grey to grey-green foliage with clusters of light lilac pink flowers from late summer to early fall; 8-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Amsonia hubrichtii</b> (Arkansas Blue Star) native with very narrow, needle-like leaves that line the stems like bottlebrushes; clusters of small, light blue, star-shaped flowers; golden fall color; sun to part shade; 3' tall; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Amsonia tabernaemontana 'Storm Cloud'</b> (Blue Star) new stems emerge near-black in Spring; dark green leaves have silver veining; light blue, star-shaped flowers cover this wide mound for many weeks in late spring and early summer; 24-30 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
* <b>Anemone 'Curtain Call Deep Rose'</b> (Japanese Anemone) dark rose pink flowers, each with a double row of petals, sit atop a small mound of green foliage; one of the final performers in the fall garden; 14-18 inches; partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Anemone 'Honorine Jobert'</b> (Japanese Anemone) lovely white flowers in the fall; best in part shade, but can handle lots of sun as well; 3-4 feet; Zone 5-----	12.99

<b>Anemone hupehensis 'September Charm'</b> (Japanese Anemone) rose pink, single flowers in late summer, 24-36 inches tall; sun to part shade; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Anemone 'Pamina'</b> (Japanese Anemone) a good choice for late summer and autumn flowering; double pink flowers on 36-inch stems; part shade is best; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Anemone sylvestris 'Madonna'</b> (Snowdrops) improvement over the species with larger 2-3 inch single, pure white, lightly fragrant flowers in spring with some rebloom in fall; more uniform than <i>Anemone sylvestris</i> ; 9-12 inches; partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Anemone x 'Whirlwind'</b> (Windflower) pure white semi-double flowers in late summer, 36 inches tall; free flowering; sun to part shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Aquilegia 'Blue Jay'</b> (Columbine) large, upward-facing blue and white flowers in late spring and early summer; 20-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia canadensis 'Little Lanterns'</b> (Columbine) easy to grow dwarf selection with tons of vibrant red and yellow pendant flowers in late spring; 12-18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia 'Cardinal'</b> (Columbine) from the Songbird Series; dramatic red sepals with white petals; sun to part shade; 28 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia 'Sunshine'</b> (Columbine) large, bright yellow double flowers; very floriferous and bright spring color; 24-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Blue &amp; White'</b> (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; small upward-facing blue and white flowers; small blue spurs; great for containers; 12-18 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Red &amp; White'</b> (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; sturdy stems of small upward facing red and white flowers bloom late spring to early summer; full to partial sun; 12-18 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aralia cordata 'Sun King'</b> (Golden Japanese Spikenard) brighten up the shade garden with this tropical looking beauty; large, bright gold leaves, tiny white flowers give way to purple-black berries in fall; foliage is greener in deep shade; 3 feet; partial shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
<b>Armeria martima 'Bloodstone'</b> (Sea Pink) tufted evergreen leaves; long flowering dark rose-red flowers in mid to late spring; sun; 6-8 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Artemisia schmidtiana 'Silver Mound'</b> (Wormwood) compact mounded plant about 8-10 inches tall; the foliage is fernlike and silver-gray; sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Aruncus aethusifolius</b> (Dwarf Goat's Beard) rather fine, ferny foliage forms a small clump; creamy white spikes in early summer; part to full shade; 12 inches tall; Zone 3 -----	9.99
* <b>Aruncus 'Chantilly Lace'</b> (Goat's Beard) sprays of lacy, cream-colored flowers in late spring to early summer completely cover the deep green foliage; Goatsbeard is similar in appearance to <i>Astilbe</i> , but more drought tolerant; 30-32 inches; partial shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
<b>Asarum europeum</b> (European Ginger) shiny round leaves make an attractive, low-growing clump; likes moist, but well-drained location in the shade; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Asclepias incarnata #2</b> (Swamp Milkweed) clusters of upturned pink flowers in June and July; host and nectar plant for Monarch butterflies; prefers moist soil; 3-4' feet; full sun; Zone 3 -----	19.99
<b>Asclepias incarnata 'Ice Ballet'</b> (Butterfly Flower) clusters of tiny white flowers in July contrast nicely against the rich green foliage; prefers moist, humus-rich soil; long-lasting cut flower; sun; 3-5 feet; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Asclepias tuberosa</b> (Butterfly Weed) a fine border plant producing brilliant orange flowers; milkweed-type pods are used in dried flower arrangements; breaks dormancy late; sun 2 feet; Zone 3 -----	12.99
<b>Aster dumosus 'Wood's Blue'</b> (New York Aster) light blue flowers in late summer; compact, dark green foliage; very mildew and rust resistant; full sun; 12-15 inches; Zone 4 -----	12.99
<b>Aster dumosus 'Wood's Pink'</b> (New York Aster) dense clusters of semi-double, clear pink flowers from late summer to mid fall; dwarf, compact plant in mildew and rust resistant; 12-15 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
<b>Aster dumosus 'Wood's Purple'</b> (New York Aster) semi-double, purple flowers atop dwarf, compact plants that do not require staking; blooms late summer to mid fall; full sun; 12-16 inches; Zone 3 -----	12.99
<b>Aster Kickin® 'Carmine Red'</b> (Aster) forms a full, dense mound of finely textured foliage that is covered in magenta red flowers with a gold button center from late summer through mid fall; maintains a naturally compact, neat habit without pruning; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
<b>Aster Kickin® 'Lilac Blue'</b> (Aster) forms a full, dense mound of finely textured foliage that is covered in lilac blue flowers with a gold button center from late summer through mid fall; maintains a naturally compact, neat habit without pruning; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
<b>Aster novae-angliae 'Purple Dome'</b> (New England Aster) deep purple flowers on a dome-shaped, compact plant in the fall; heavy bloomer; mildew resistant; sun; 18 inches; Zone 3 -----	12.99

<b>Astilbe arendsii 'Fanal'</b> (False Spirea) an arendsii type; early red flowers, 20-24 inches tall; dark bronze foliage; mulch to hold moisture; part shade; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe arendsii 'Rhythm &amp; Blues'</b> (False Spirea) early summer bloomer with bright raspberry-pink plumes and dark green foliage; full shade; 25 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
* <b>Astilbe arendsii 'Weisse Gloria'</b> (False Spirea) a profuse bloomer with full, stocky clear white plumes; loves moisture; partial sun to shade; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe chinensis 'Vision in Red'</b> (False Spirea) red version of 'Visions'; a chinensis type; red plumes 18-24 inches tall; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe chinensis 'Visions'</b> (False Spirea) a chinensis type; raspberry purple plumes standing 12-15 inches tall; late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe 'Color Flash'</b> (False Spirea) green spring foliage matures to a striking blend of burgundy, purple and green during summer; light pink plumes in early summer; low-growing but wide-spreading habit; 18-20 inches; partial shade; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe 'Delft Lace'</b> (False Spirea) reddish stems bear open panicles of delicate peach-pink flowers; deep blue-green waxy foliage with silver overlay; 24-36 inches; partial shade; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe japonica 'Montgomery'</b> (False Spirea) a japonica type; dark red plumes standing 24 inches tall; mid- to late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Astilbe japonica 'Peach Blossom'</b> (False Spirea) light salmon-pink airy blooms open early to midseason; likes moist soil and partial shade; 20 inches tall; plant 18 inches apart; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Astrantia major 'Star Of Beauty'</b> (Masterwort) starry carmine rose flowers with bright white centers; long flowering; shade tolerant; 20-24 inches; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Astrantia 'Star of Fire'</b> (Masterwort) long-lasting burgundy red flowers with white centers accented with dark purple stems; vigorous grower; 20 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 3-----	12.99
* <b>Baptisia 'American Goldfinch'</b> (False Indigo) golden yellow flower spikes rise up above its wide habit; one of the most floriferous Baptisia; perfect specimen for filling a large space or for mass plantings; 36-42 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Baptisia australis</b> (False Indigo) upright, shrub-like plant 3-4 feet tall, with blue-green leaves and indigo-blue flowers in late spring, followed by black seed pods; sun to part shade; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Baptisia Decadence® 'Lemon Meringue'</b> (False Indigo) charcoal buds open to bright lemon yellow flowers from late spring to early summer; impressive vigor for a yellow Baptisia; vase-shaped blue-green foliage; 3 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Baptisia Decadence® 'Pink Truffles'</b> (False Indigo) a new color in Baptisia!; soft pink blooms in late spring produced atop a compact, shorter mound that fits easily into any garden; 30-36 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Belamcanda chinensis 'Freckle Face'</b> (Blackberry Lily) 2 inch showy orange flowers in late summer with heavy red speckling and shading; 24 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
<b>Belamcanda flava 'Hello Yellow'</b> (Blackberry Lily) clear yellow flowers on outstanding dwarf plant, 18 inches tall; seed heads resemble clusters of blackberries in late summer; sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
<b>Bergenia cordifolia 'Winter Glow'</b> (Saxifraga) red flowers in mid-Spring above shiny foliage; regarded as an improved 'Rotblum'; interesting fall and winter foliage; part shade is best; 12-15 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Bergenia 'Sakura'</b> (Heartleaf Bergenia, Pigsqueak) pink flowers with dark pink veining bloom early to late spring; beautiful bold color for the partial sun to shade garden; 16 inches; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla</b> (Alkanet) large heart-shaped leaves with small, blue, forget-me-not flowers in spring; likes moisture and part to full shade; 12 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Alexander's Great'</b> (Alkanet) gigantic clumps carry bushel basket-sized leaves with silver flecking; makes a dramatic statement in the landscape; 28 inch spread; full to partial shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Emerald Mist'</b> (Heartleaf Brunnera) heavier silver bars connect to form a silver collar around the perimeter of the leaf; light silver-dusting over entire leaf; baby blue flowers; part shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3	14.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Jack Frost'</b> (Alkanet) frosty silver overlay with light green veination makes leaves resemble cracked porcelain; blue forget-me-not flowers in spring; shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Silver Heart'</b> (Alkanet) almost solid silver foliage with narrow green veins; greater heat tolerance than 'Looking Glass'; delicate sky-blue flowers in early spring; 14-16 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
<b>Brunnera macrophylla 'Variegata'</b> (Alkanet) large green leaves boldly variegated with creamy-white color; needs shade and good moisture to prevent margins from scorching; blue flowers; 12 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
<b>Buddleia 'Bicolor'</b> (Butterfly Bush) gray-green foliage; fragrant, lavender and yellow flowers up to 10 inches long; sun; 6-8 feet; Zone 5 -----	14.99

* <b>Buddleia 'Dark Dynasty'</b> (Butterfly Bush) rich royal purple, fragrant flowers are produced in late summer and last for many weeks; forms a neat, rounded clump of dark green foliage; 3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Buddleia davidii 'White Profusion'</b> (Butterfly Bush) beautiful white flower clusters on a woody bush 5-7 feet tall; attracts butterflies; cut back in spring; sun; Zone 5-----	9.99
* <b>Buddleia 'Little Angel'</b> (Butterfly Bush) very long, pure white flower panicles appear above perfectly mounded foliage; blooms a few weeks earlier than most varieties; 3-3.5 feet tall; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Buddleia 'Little Nugget'</b> (Butterfly Bush) magenta purple flowers are nicely set against brilliant gold foliage; flowers deepen to blue-purple with age; blooms mid summer to early fall; 30-36 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Buddleia Lo &amp; Behold® 'Blue Chip'</b> (Butterfly Bush) a miniature butterfly bush! Grows to no more than 2 feet high and wide and blooms from early summer into autumn: full sun; Zone 5-----	14.99
<b>Buddleia Lo &amp; Behold® 'Blue Chip Jr.'</b> (Butterfly Bush) smaller and less brittle than the original 'Blue Chip'; spikes of bluish purple flowers from mid summer to frost; 20-28 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	19.99
<b>Buddleia Lo &amp; Behold® 'Ice Chip'</b> (Dwarf Butterfly Bush) a profusion of pure white flowers against a backdrop of silvery foliage; blooms continuously; seedless; low, spreading plant; full sun; 2' tall and wide; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Buddleia Lo &amp; Behold® 'Pink Micro Chip'</b> (Butterfly Bush) spikes of orchid pink blooms from mid summer to frost; 18-24 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	19.99
<b>Buddleia 'Miss Molly'</b> (Butterfly Bush) Good golly! Outstanding dark Sangria-red color; full sun; 4'-5' tall; cut back in spring; Zone 5 -----	19.99
<b>Buddleia 'Miss Molly' #3</b> (Butterfly Bush) Good golly! Outstanding dark Sangria-red color; full sun; 4'-5' tall; cut back in spring; Zone 5 -----	29.99
<b>Buddleia 'Miss Pearl'</b> (Butterfly Bush) elegant, pure white flowers; attracts butterflies and hummingbirds; cut back in spring; compact habit, growing 4'-5'; full sun; Zone 5-----	14.99
* <b>Buddleia 'Pugster Periwinkle' #3</b> (Butterfly Bush) the Pugster series boasts huge, full sized flowers on a compact and sturdy frame; strong and thick stems will ensure better winter survival; soft purple flowers; 2 feet tall x 2-3 feet wide; full sun; Zone 5 -----	29.99
* <b>Buddleia 'Pugster Pink' #3</b> (Butterfly Bush) the Pugster series boasts huge, full sized flowers on a compact and sturdy frame; strong and thick stems will ensure better winter survival; fragrant pink flowers; 2 feet tall x 2-3 feet wide; full sun; Zone 5-----	29.99
<b>Campanula carpatica 'Rapido Blue'</b> (Bellflower) violet blue, cup shaped flowers bloom up to 4 weeks earlier than the 'Clips' varieties; 5-7 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Campanula carpatica 'Rapido White'</b> (Bellflower) pure white, cup shaped flowers bloom up to 4 weeks earlier than the 'Clips' varieties; 5-7 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Campanula garg. 'Dickson's Gold'</b> (Bellflower) low growing toothed foliage is bright gold in spring, fading to a chartreuse green by June; makes a striking combo with blue blooming varieties; sun to partial shade; 4-6 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Campanula glomerata 'Genti Blue'</b> (Clustered Bellflower) clustered, bell-shaped, violet blue flowers atop dark green foliage; compact habit and long bloom season from late spring through mid summer; 16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 5-----	9.99
<b>Campanula glomerata 'Genti White'</b> (Clustered Bellflower) clustered, bell-shaped, pure white flowers atop dark green foliage; compact habit and long bloom season from late spring through mid summer; 18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Campanula persicifolia 'Takion Blue'</b> (Bellflower) a showy display of lavender blue, bell-shaped, upward and outward facing flowers in spring; compact habit; 16-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Campanula poscharskyana 'Blue Waterfall'</b> (Bellflower) vigorous low-growing habit with sprays of starry lavender-blue flowers all summer; good groundcover; sun; 8-10 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Carex caryophylla 'Beatlemania'</b> (Sedge) twist and shout over this mophead of green and gold; low grower at 6 inches, but up to 24 inches wide; best in moist, rich soil in light shade; Zone 5 -----	14.99
<b>Carex elata 'Bowles Golden'</b> (Gold Sedge) bright gold foliage with narrow green margins; spectacular with blue Hosta or gold edged Hosta; moisture loving; part shade; 2-3'; Zone 5 -----	12.99
<b>Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'</b> (Variegated Sedge) compact tufts of 1/2 inch wide, dark green leaves with clear white borders; excellent low maintenance ground cover; moderate spread; 12 inches; Zone 5 -----	12.99
<b>Centaurea montana 'Amethyst in Snow'</b> (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) large buds burst to reveal pure white trumpet-shaped petals; royal purple centers; fast grower; 24 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Centaurea montana 'Blue'</b> (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) blue fringed blooms; attracts butterflies; favorite cut flower; sun; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99

<b>Cerastium tomentosum 'Yo Yo'</b> (Snow in Summer) ground cover that is highly valued for its woolly-gray foliage; good specimen for rock gardens or edging; white flowers in May and June; sun; 4-6 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
<b>Ceratostigma plumbaginoides</b> (Plumbago, Leadwort) brilliant blue flowers from late summer to the first hard frost; bronzy-red foliage in fall; excellent groundcover for late season interest; 8-12 inches; best in partial shade; Zone 5-----	9.99
<b>Chelone lyonii 'Hot Lips'</b> (Turtlehead) deep green foliage with bronze-green tinge; requires moisture; rose pink flowers in late summer; attracts butterflies; sun to part shade; up to 3 feet; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Chelone lyonii 'Tiny Tortuga'</b> (Turtlehead) attractive mound of dark green foliage with hot pink flowers in mid-late summer; grows best in moist soil; 12-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
<b>Chrysanthemum Mammoth® 'Lavender Daisy' #2</b> (Hardy Garden Mum) lavender, daisy-shaped flowers bloom late summer to fall; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Chrysanthemum Mammoth® 'Red Daisy' #2</b> (Hardy Garden Mum) semi-double red with bright yellow centers; heat tolerant; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
<b>Chrysanthemum Mammoth® 'Yellow Quill' #2</b> (Hardy Garden Mum) unique semi-double bright yellow flowers with spoon shaped petals; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
<b>Chrysanthemum 'Matchsticks' #2</b> (Hardy Garden Mum) spoon shaped petals are golden yellow with fire red tips just like a matchstick; 18-24 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	14.99
