TROPICAL MARGINAL PLANTS

- Canna 'Happy Carmen'** a vigorous grower with self cleaning, deep red blooms; will give you a summer-long display of color; 20 inches; full to partial sun; lift in fall to overwinter ----- 7.99
- Canna 'Happy Cleo'** large clusters of orange flowers with golden undertones bloom all summer atop a compact, virus-free plant; blooms are self-cleaning; 18-22 inches; full to partial sun; lift in fall to overwinter ----- 7.99
- Canna 'Happy Julia'** a super-compact, vigorous grower with deep salmon pink flowers and dark burgundy-green foliage; blooms are self-cleaning; 18-22 inches; full to partial sun; left in fall to overwinter----- 7.99

HARDY WATER LILIES

- Hardy - 'Charlene Strawn'** (Hardy Water Lily) large, fragrant, 5-7 inch yellow flowers have a long blooming season; dark green lily pads; sun to partial shade; water depth 6-28 inches; Zone 3 ----- 29.99

LOTUS

- Nelumbo 'Beautiful Dancer'** one of the first lotus to bloom; opens a vivid pink and matures to light yellow with pink on the outer edges of petals; 18-30 inches; Zone 3----- 59.99
- Nelumbo 'Russian Red'** semi-double, 8-12in large red flowers are held high above large leaves; 48-60 inches; Zone 3 ----- 74.99
- Nelumbo 'Sparks'** a heavy bloomer with deep red buds that open to deep pink blossoms; 18-30 inches; Zone 3 ----- 59.99

OXYGENATORS

- Rotala indica** (Red Rotala) long stems with small reddish-green leaves; oxygenator; 10-12 inches; Zone 9----- 7.99

Grasses:

- Andropogon gerardii 'Red October'** (Big Bluestem) a tallgrass prairie native which features an upright clump of blue-green foliage with red tinges in summer; turns reddish bronze with lavender tones in fall after frost; full sun; 4-6 feet; Zone 4 ----- 14.99
- Schizachyrium scoparium 'Smoke Signal'** (Little Bluestem) strictly upright habit of blue-green foliage that takes on scarlet red tones in late summer and turns deeper red-purple in fall; tiny, tan seed heads in early fall; 3-4 feet; full sun; Zone 3 ----- 14.99

Hostas:

Size: After the name of each hosta, we have listed the size of the plant, based upon the approximate diameter of the plant at maturity. Although some hostas grow more upright than others, height will generally correspond to diameter (i.e., the larger the diameter, the taller the plant).

Diameter of mature plant:

[D] = Dwarf, up to 6" [S] = Small, 8"-16" [MS] = Medium-Small, 18"-24" [M] = Medium, 26"-36"

- Age of Gold** [L] large, smooth, golden yellow leaves show off their best color in morning sun or filtered shade; upright spreading habit; 25in tall x 44in wide (NW) ----- 20.00
- Diamond Lake** [M] heart-shaped blue leaves are thick and heavily corrugated with wavy margins; large leaves measure up to 9 in wide by 11 in long; grows to 17in tall x 25-28in wide (L) ----- 20.00
- Etched Glass** [M] a sport of 'Stained Glass' with wider margins and thicker leaves; very wide, dark green margins with bright yellow centers and a light green pattern in between; very large and fragrant near-white flowers; 18in tall x 36in wide (NW) ----- 20.00
- Honey Bear** [L] dark green leaf centers with honey-yellow margins; a fast growing and sun tolerant variety with fragrant flowers; mature leaves become rounded and somewhat puckered; 20in tall x 42in wide ----- 30.00
- Honey Pie** [ML] a cross of 'September Sun' and *H. plantaginea* with the best characteristics of both; thick puckered gold leaves with fragrant flowers; vigorous grower; a little extra sun brings out a nice yellow color; 18in x 40in (L) 20.00
- Hovercraft** [M] round leaves have a nice blue color and seem to float over their petioles; 16in tall x 30in wide ----- 25.00
- Jetstream** [ML] forms a perfect clump with waxy blue leaves all neatly arranged; 26in tall x 40in wide ----- 20.00
- Twist Tie** [S] a small blue-green hosta with very upright, twisted leaves; very good substance; 10in tall x 18in wide ----- 20.00
- Wu-La-La** [XL] a variegated sport of 'Empress Wu' with the same size and presence, and good substance; blue-green leaves with a striking apple-green margin (L) ----- 20.00

Perennials:

- Achillea millefolium 'New Vintage Red'** (Yarrow) hot pink-red flowers are long blooming and do not fade to brown like other varieties; holds its compact shape and reblooms very well; 12-14 inches; full sun; Zone 3 ----- 9.99
- Achillea ptarmica 'Peter Cottontail'** (Yarrow) large, ivory-white flowers over a low, mounding habit of green foliage; full to partial sun; 18-24 inches; Zone 3 ----- 12.99
- Achillea 'Sassy Summer Lemon'** (Yarrow) huge flower heads of bright, sunny yellow blooms all summer atop silver grey foliage; 28-32 inches; full sun; Zone 3 ----- 9.99
- Agastache 'Kudos Coral'** (Dwarf Hummingbird Mint) dense coral colored plumes have a sweet honey-mint scent; long lasting blooms from June through September; 20 inches; full sun; Zone 5 ----- 12.99
- Agastache 'Kudos Mandarin'** (Dwarf Hummingbird Mint) cheery, bright orange flowers last for many months from June through September; 17-20 inches; full sun; Zone 5 ----- 12.99

Baptisia Decadence® 'Dark Chocolate' (False Indigo) very long flower spikes with nearly black, charcoal-purple flowers that extend well above the foliage; forms a very full and bushy habit; 36-42 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	14.99
Baptisia Decadence® 'Pink Lemonade' (False Indigo) soft yellow flowers age to dusty raspberry-purple, with both colors appearing on the stem at the same time; very full and bushy habit; full sun; 42-48 inches; Zone 4	14.99
Buddleia 'Blue Knight' (Butterfly Bush) long, 10-12 inches, flower panicles open light lavender-purple and deepen to blue-purple with age; forms a dense clump of minty green leaves; full sun; 42-48 inches; Zone 5	14.99
Buddleia 'Grand Cascade' (Butterfly Bush) cascading light lavender-purple flower panicles are enormous at 12-14 inches long and 4 inches thick; blooms summer to early fall; 6 feet tall; cut back to 1 foot tall in spring; full sun; Zone 5	14.99
Buddleia 'Pink Cascade' (Butterfly Bush) cascading light apple blossom pink flower panicles are 8-10 inches long and bloom late summer to early fall; minty green foliage; 5 feet tall; cut back to 1 foot tall in spring; full sun; Zone 5	14.99
Buddleia 'Prince Charming' (Butterfly Bush) 10 inch long, bright cerise-pink flower spikes cover the upright, gumdrop-shaped habit; 42-48 inches; full sun; Zone 5	14.99
Buddleia Pugster White® (Butterfly Bush) the Pugster® series boasts huge, full sized flowers on a compact and sturdy frame; crisp white blooms have a honey-sweet fragrance; 24in tall x 24-36in wide; full sun; Zone 5	19.99
Calamintha 'Marvelette Blue' (Catmint) early blooming masses of blue-purple flowers on upright spikes; green foliage has a minty fragrance and a clumping habit; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	12.99
Campanula 'Violet Teacups' (Bellflower) intense violet-purple flowers cover the plant in spring; provides bold color along the front of the border or along pathways; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3	9.99
Coreopsis Uptick 'Cream & Red' (Tickseed) large 3 inch cream flowers with dark red centers; forms a compact tidy mound of mildew resistant foliage; 12-14 inches; full sun; Zone 4	9.99
Echinacea 'Atomic Orange' (Coneflower) large, vibrant tangerine-orange flowers with a dark cone; 16-18 inches; full sun; Zone 4	14.99
Echinacea 'Canary' (Coneflower) large, 5 inch golden-yellow flowers with overlapping petals and golden-yellow cones; flowers mature to soft yellow; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4	14.99
Echinacea 'Coral Craze' (Coneflower) large, 5 inch vibrant coral pink flowers mature to lavender pink; dark, near black stems have a matching dark cone; 26-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	14.99
Echinacea Kismet® Red (Coneflower) early blooming, large, bright red flowers and reddish black cones; reblooms all summer on a dense, compact habit; 16-18 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	14.99
Echinacea 'Tweety' (Coneflower) a cheerful burst of large, canary yellow flowers from early summer to fall on a truly dwarf plant; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	14.99
Helleborus Honeymoon 'Vegas Nights' (Lenten Rose) 3 inch, single slate gray to dark purple flowers; 18-24 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 4	19.99
Helleborus 'Romantic Getaway' #1 (Lenten Rose) 3 inch, single white flowers with a dramatic red patterned center; 18-24 inches; partial shade; Zone 4	19.99
Helleborus 'Tropical Sunset' (Lenten Rose) 3 inch, single creamy yellow flowers are dramatically streaked with burgundy red veining and picotee edge; 18-24 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 4	19.99
Heuchera Dolce® 'Cherry Truffles' (Coral Bells) new leaves emerge bright red and heavily ruffled and mature to a rich mahogany red in summer; light pink flowers; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4	14.99
Heuchera Dolce® 'Wildberry' (Coral Bells) large, scalloped, glossy leaves are a bold shade of purple with charcoal veins; white flowers in mid summer; 10-14 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4	14.99

Heuchera Primo 'Peachberry Ice' (Coral Bells) large, apricot-orange leaves have a silver overlay; pronounced ruffling reveals bright pink undersides of the leaves; cream flowers in mid summer; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4	16.99
Heuchera 'Timeless Treasure' (Coral Bells) small, pewter leaves with dark purple veins; large rosy pink flowers put on a show from early summer to mid fall; 8-10 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4	14.99
Hibiscus 'Mocha Moon' #3 (Rose Mallow) huge 7-8in, slightly cupped pure white flowers with a scarlet red eye are produced from the top to the bottom of the plant; deep bronze-green foliage; 4 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4	24.99
Hibiscus Summerific® 'Berry Awesome' #3 (Rose Mallow) 7-8in lavender-pink, ruffled flowers have a red eye and contrast nicely with dark olive green foliage; densely compact habit of maple-like leaves; 4 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4	24.99
Hibiscus Summerific® 'Holy Grail' #3 (Rose Mallow) 8-9in rich, deep red flowers are set off by densely packed near-black leaves; bright green calyxes starkly contrast the dark foliage; 4 ft; full to partial sun; Zone 4	24.99

Iris g. 'Apricot Silk' (Tall Bearded Iris) peach flowers with a gold beard; blooms mid spring; 18 inches; full sun; Zone 3--	12.99
Iris g. 'Bernice's Legacy' (Tall Bearded Iris) a vigorous grower with flowers a beautiful blend of garnet and cinnamon; blooms in spring and may rebloom later in the season; 32 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Iris g. 'His Royal Highness' (Tall Bearded Iris) ruffled, medium purple standards and falls; blooms in spring and may rebloom in fall; 36 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99

Paeonia 'Bowl of Beauty' (Garden Peony) fuchsia pink petals create a bowl around the pale lemon yellow center of each bloom; full sun; 30-36 inches; Zone 4-----	25.00
Paeonia 'Finest Hour' large, airy semi-double blooms are salmon pink with lighter tinged petal edges; blooms mid season; 32 inches; full sun; Zone 2-----	25.00
Phlox Bambini® 'Candy Crush' (Dwarf Garden Phlox) large, fragrant flower heads of pink and white pinwheel flowers; a naturally compact habit and mildew resistant foliage; will rebloom if deadheaded; 10-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
Phlox Bambini® 'Sweet Tart' (Dwarf Garden Phlox) fragrant, bright pink flowers have an exceptionally long bloom time and rebloom if deadheaded; 10-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Phlox 'Bedazzled Orchid' (Hybrid Spring Phlox) lavender pink flowers with a subtle purple eye produced over a rounded, spreading habit; a spring favorite for your garden!; 6-8 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Phlox 'Forever Pink' (Dwarf Garden Phlox) 1 inch wide vibrant purple-pink blooms cover the mound in June with repeat bloom well into October; a compact clump-forming early-blooming phlox; 12-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99

Primula vulgaris Belarina® Buttercup (Primrose) butter-yellow double flowers bloom very early spring and have a long spring bloom; 7-9 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Pulmonaria 'Pretty in Pink' (Lungwort) large clusters of bright, rose pink flowers in late spring; dark green leaves specked with silver form a low and wide habit; 14-16 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Rudbeckia 'American Gold Rush' (Black-Eyed Susan) produces a dome of yellow daisy flowers from summer through fall atop a compact plant; resistant to leaf spot, even in humid conditions; 20-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Salvia Color Spires® 'Pink Dawn' (Meadow Sage) fuchsia buds open into cotton candy pink blooms held on thick, dark, well-branched stems; 16-20 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Salvia nemorosa 'Blue Marvel' (Meadow Sage) large, bright violet-blue blooms in early spring will rebloom continuously through fall with deadheading; compact, gray-green foliage is deer and rabbit resistant; 10-12 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	9.99
Salvia nemorosa 'Bumbleblue' (Meadow Sage) violet-blue flower spikes bloom in early summer; a shorter stature makes it a perfect selection for the front of the perennial border; 12-14 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99

Sedum 'Bundle of Joy' (Stonecrop) this white flowering sport of 'Pure Joy' forms a perfect dome covered in pure white flowers in early fall; 10-12 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Sedum takesimense Atlantis (Stonecrop) a groundcover type with small, serrated leaves that are dark green with very wide creamy yellow margins; foliage becomes pink tinged during cold temps in late fall; 4-6 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Sempervivum 'Peggy' (Hen & Chicks) leaves are purple in spring and transition to deep red in summer; 4-6 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
Sempervivum 'Pilioseum' (Hen & Chicks) forms medium to large rosettes of grey-green leaves; good choice for rock gardens or containers; 3-4 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
Veronica Magic Show® 'Wizard of Ahhs' (Spike Speedwell) thick spikes of violet-blue flowers cover the top half of the plant; one of the earliest Veronica to bloom; 14-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99

Caragana arborescens 'Walker' #10 (Siberian Peashrub) weeping form with fine textured, fern-like foliage and small, bright yellow flowers; yellow fall color; 8' tall and wide; Zone 2 -----	149.99
Catalpa speciosa Heartland® #10 (Catalpa) selection of native tree; upright grower with large, dark green leaves; large white flower clusters in early June; sun; 50' tall; spread 25'; Zone 5 -----	179.99
Cercis canadensis 'Forest Pansy' #10 (Redbud) deep purple foliage and magenta rose flowers on an ornamental tree; yellow-orange fall color; best in part shade; 20' tall and wide; Zone 5 -----	199.99

Chamaecyparis pisifera 'Golden Pin Cushion' (Dwarf False Cypress) a handsome accent in the rock garden or other small space; forms a low, irregular mound; brighter yellow with some morning sun; Zone 4-----	17.99
Ulmus parviflora 'Hokkaido' (Dwarf Chinese Elm) tiny in every way; makes for a good container or bonsai plant; congested growth and stocky trunk; sun; 1-3' tall and wide; Zone 4-----	17.99

Vines:

Clematis Bernadine silvery lavender-blue flowers accented by maroon anthers bloom late spring to early fall; a great option for a container or for the small garden at only 3-4 feet; partial shade; Zone 4, pruning group 3 -----	19.99
Clematis Kitty beautiful near white flowers bloom May to October; this charming compact clematis is ideal for growing in a container on the deck or in the garden; grows 3-4 feet; partial shade; Zone 4; pruning group 3-----	24.99
Clematis Nubia dark red flowers appear in spring and rebloom in summer; blooms prolifically on a compact plant that quickly reaches 4 to 6 feet tall; an improvement over 'Rebecca'; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 3 ---	19.99
Clematis Sarah Elizabeth blooms are a distinctive shade of candy pink and stand out nicely against dark foliage; flowers from May to September; ideal in light shade; 4-5 feet; Zone 4; pruning group 3-----	24.99
