* Achillea 'Firefly Amethyst' (Yarrow) bright lavender pink flowers age to light pink; tall, sturdy, upright habit; 18-22 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
* Achillea 'Firefly Diamond' (Yarrow) ivory white flowers contrast nicely with dark green foliage; flowers remain attractive as they age; tall and sturdy habit; 24-28 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
* Achillea 'Firefly Sunshine' (Yarrow) bright yellow flowers for lasting color throughout the summer; tall, sturdy, upright habit; 28-30 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
Achillea millefolium 'New Vintage Red' (Yarrow) hot pink-red flowers are long blooming and do not fade to brown like other varieties; holds its compact shape and reblooms very well; 12-14 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
* Achillea millefolium 'New Vintage Violet' (Yarrow) magenta-purple flowers are long blooming and do not fade to brown; holds its compact shape and reblooms very well; trim spent blooms for repeat blooming; 12-14 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Achillea ptarmica 'Peter Cottontail' (Yarrow) large, ivory-white flowers over a low, mounding habit of green foliage; full to partial sun; 18-24 inches; Zone 3-----	12.99
* Actaea pachypoda 'Misty Blue' (White Baneberry) a native perennial grown for its unusual white berries on red stems in summer; white flower plumes in spring; prefers moist shade; 30-36 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
Agastache 'Blue Fortune' (Anise Hyssop) lavender blue bottlebrush-like flowers from mid summer to early fall; this long bloomer provides color late in the season; 24-36 inches; sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Agastache 'Kudos Coral' (Dwarf Hummingbird Mint) dense coral colored plumes have a sweet honey-mint scent; long lasting blooms from June through September; 20 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	12.99
Agastache 'Kudos Mandarin' (Dwarf Hummingbird Mint) cheery, bright orange flowers last for many months from June through September; 17-20 inches; full sun; Zone 5-----	12.99
# Ajuga reptans 'Black Scallop' (Bugleweed) smaller-scale groundcover with glossy, near-black, scalloped leaves; stays compact; blue flowers; sun or shade; Zone 4-----	9.99
# Ajuga reptans 'Burgundy Glow' (Bugleweed) variegated foliage of burgundy, creamy white and green which gives a vivid tricolor effect; blue flowers on 6 inch spikes; sun or shade; Zone 3-----	9.99
Alcea 'Fiesta Time' (Hollyhock) relatively short spikes of double, cherry pink, fringed blossoms beginning in midsummer; 36 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Alcea rosea Halo Series 'Cerise' (Hollyhock) large, cerise pink flowers with a deep purple halo; 5-6 feet; full sun; per the breeder, the halo series are Zone 3 hardy perennials-----	9.99
Alcea rosea 'Mars Magic' (Hollyhock) single, bright red flowers bloom mid summer; a truly perennial hollyhock, not biennial!; 5-6 feet; full sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Alchemilla mollis 'Thriller' (Lady's Mantle) tiny star-shaped, green-yellow blooms; excellent gray-green foliage; slightly larger than mollis yet remains compact; shade; 18-24 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
Allium 'Medusa' (Ornamental Onion) 2 inch clusters of light amethyst purple flowers bloom in summer; low mound of gray-green narrow foliage; 18-20 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	16.99
# Allium 'Millenium' (Ornamental Onion) a picture perfect, compact, upright clump of glossy green leaves is covered in a profusion of 2 inch bright rosy purple flower clusters in mid to late summer; 15-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 5-----	14.99
* Allium 'Serendipity' (Ornamental Onion) globe-like rosy-purple flowers bloom profusely in mid to late summer; a sport of 'Millenium' with all the same great qualities and the addition of blue foliage; 15-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99

# Amsonia hubrichtii (Arkansas Blue Star) native with very narrow, needle-like leaves that line the stems like bottlebrushes; clusters of small, light blue, star-shaped flowers; golden fall color; sun to part shade; 3' tall; Zone 4-----	12.99
* Amsonia 'Starstruck' (Blue Star) a very full habit of vibrant green leaves with lighter midribs and dark olive stems; blue star-shaped flowers cover the plant for many weeks in late spring and early summer; 20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
# Amsonia tabernaemontana 'Storm Cloud' (Blue Star) new stems emerge near-black in Spring; dark green leaves have silver veining; light blue, star-shaped flowers cover this wide mound for many weeks in late spring and early summer; 24-30 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
Anemone Fall in Love 'Sweetly' (Japanese Anemone) semi-double, rose pink flowers in early fall are produced above a large mound of dark green foliage; 20-26 inches; best in partial shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
Anemone 'Honorine Jobert' (Japanese Anemone) lovely white flowers in the fall; best in part shade, but can handle lots of sun as well; 3-4 feet; Zone 5-----	12.99
# Anemone hupehensis 'September Charm' (Japanese Anemone) rose pink, single flowers in late summer, 24-36 inches tall; sun to part shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
* Anemone 'Spring Beauty' (Japanese Anemone) a pink spring-blooming variety; hot pink flowers are held above very upright foliage; flowers are sterile so they won't reseed like <i>A. sylvestris</i> ; 18 inches; partial shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
# Anemone sylvestris (Snowdrops) pure white flowers in spring on 18-inch plant; vigorous spreader for partly shaded location; Zone 3-----	12.99
Aquilegia 'Blue Jay' (Columbine) large, upward-facing blue and white flowers in late spring and early summer; 20-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Cardinal' (Columbine) from the Songbird Series; dramatic red sepals with white petals; sun to part shade; 28 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Sunshine' (Columbine) large, bright yellow double flowers; very floriferous and bright spring color; 24-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Blue & White' (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; small upward-facing blue and white flowers; small blue spurs; great for containers; 12-18 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia vulgaris 'Winky Red & White' (Columbine) compact mounds of blue-green foliage; sturdy stems of small upward facing red and white flowers bloom late spring to early summer; full to partial sun; 12-18 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
# Aralia cordata 'Sun King' (Golden Japanese Spikenard) brighten up the shade garden with this tropical looking beauty; large, bright gold leaves, tiny white flowers give way to purple-black berries in fall; foliage is greener in deep shade; 3 feet; partial shade; Zone 3-----	14.99
Armeria martima 'Bloodstone' (Sea Pink) tufted evergreen leaves; long flowering dark rose-red flowers in mid to late spring; sun; 6-8 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
# Artemisia schmidtiana 'Silver Mound' (Wormwood) compact mounded plant about 8-10 inches tall; the foliage is fernlike and silver-gray; sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
* Artemisia versicolor 'Sea Foam' (Curlique Sage) lacy, silvery blue foliage forms an attractive clump-forming groundcover; needs good drainage and best with minimal water once established; 8-12 inches x 20-36 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
# Aruncus aethusifolius (Dwarf Goat's Beard) rather fine, ferny foliage forms a small clump; creamy white spikes in early summer; part to full shade; 12 inches tall; Zone 3-----	12.99
# Aruncus 'Chantilly Lace' (Goat's Beard) sprays of lacy, cream-colored flowers in late spring to early summer completely cover the deep green foliage; Goatsbeard is similar in appearance to <i>Astilbe</i> , but more drought tolerant; 30-32 inches; partial shade; Zone 3-----	14.99
Asarum canadense (Canadian Ginger) heart shaped deciduous leaves up to 7 inches wide; prefers organic-rich soil and plenty of moisture; shade; 6-8 inches; Zone 3-----	14.99
# Asarum europeum (European Ginger) shiny round leaves make an attractive, low-growing clump; likes moist, but well-drained location in the shade; Zone 5-----	14.99
Asclepias incarnata #2 (Swamp Milkweed) clusters of upturned pink flowers in June and July; host and nectar plant for Monarch butterflies; prefers moist soil; 3-4' feet; full sun; Zone 3-----	24.99
Asclepias incarnata 'Cinderella' (Swamp Milkweed) long-lasting, fragrant pink flowers on a 3-4 foot tall plant; attracts butterflies; full sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
# Asclepias tuberosa (Butterfly Weed) a fine border plant producing brilliant orange flowers; milkweed-type pods are used in dried flower arrangements; breaks dormancy late; sun 2 feet; Zone 3-----	12.99

Aster Kickin® 'Carmine Red' (Aster) forms a full, dense mound of finely textured foliage that is covered in magenta red flowers with a gold button center from late summer through mid fall; maintains a naturally compact, neat habit without pruning; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
Aster Kickin® 'Lilac Blue' (Aster) forms a full, dense mound of finely textured foliage that is covered in lilac blue flowers with a gold button center from late summer through mid fall; maintains a naturally compact, neat habit without pruning; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
Aster novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' (New England Aster) deep purple flowers on a dome-shaped, compact plant in the fall; heavy bloomer; mildew resistant; sun; 18 inches; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Astilbe arendsii 'Fanal' (False Spirea) an arendsii type; early red flowers, 20-24 inches tall; dark bronze foliage; mulch to hold moisture; part shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Astilbe chinensis 'Vision in Red' (False Spirea) red version of 'Visions'; a chinensis type; red plumes 18-24 inches tall; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Astilbe chinensis 'Visions' (False Spirea) a chinensis type; raspberry purple plumes standing 12-15 inches tall; late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4 -----	12.99
# Astilbe 'Delft Lace' (False Spirea) reddish stems bear open panicles of delicate peach-pink flowers; deep blue-green waxy foliage with silver overlay; 24-36 inches; partial shade; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Astilbe japonica 'Deutschland' (False Spirea) a japonica type; white plumes standing 20-24 inches tall; early season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Astilbe japonica 'Montgomery' (False Spirea) a japonica type; dark red plumes standing 24 inches tall; mid- to late season; shade; mulch to retain moisture; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Astilbe simplicifolia 'Key Largo' (False Spirea) feather-like plumes, in shades of pink above glossy green foliage; flower spikes to 15 inches; rebloomer; shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Astrantia 'Star of Fire' (Masterwort) long-lasting burgundy red flowers with white centers accented with dark purple stems; vigorous grower; 20 inches; partial to full shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Baptisia 'American Goldfinch' (False Indigo) golden yellow flower spikes rise up above its wide habit; one of the most floriferous Baptisia; perfect specimen for filling a large space or for mass plantings; 36-42 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
# Baptisia australis (False Indigo) upright, shrub-like plant 3-4 feet tall, with blue-green leaves and indigo-blue flowers in late spring, followed by black seed pods; sun to part shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Baptisia Decadence® 'Dark Chocolate' (False Indigo) very long flower spikes with nearly black, charcoal-purple flowers that extend well above the foliage; forms a very full and bushy habit; 36-42 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4	16.99
Baptisia Decadence® 'Lemon Meringue' (False Indigo) charcoal buds open to bright lemon yellow flowers from late spring to early summer; impressive vigor for a yellow Baptisia; vase-shaped blue-green foliage; 3 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	16.99
Baptisia Decadence® 'Pink Lemonade' (False Indigo) soft yellow flowers age to dusty raspberry-purple, with both colors appearing on the stem at the same time; very full and bushy habit; full sun; 42-48 inches; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Baptisia Decadence® 'Sparkling Sapphires' (False Indigo) intensely vibrant violet blue blooms on eight inch long spikes; attractive grey-green foliage; 30-36 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	16.99
* Baptisia 'Violet Dusk' (False Indigo) Lavender violet flowers on a unique vase-like habit; although 3 feet wide, the base of the plant is relatively narrow, leaving space to plant underneath; 36-42 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 --	14.99
# Belamcanda chinensis 'Freckle Face' (Blackberry Lily) 2 inch showy orange flowers in late summer with heavy red speckling and shading; 24 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
# Belamcanda flava 'Hello Yellow' (Blackberry Lily) clear yellow flowers on outstanding dwarf plant, 18 inches tall; seed heads resemble clusters of blackberries in late summer; sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
* Bergenia Dragonfly Sakura (Pig Squeak) a profuse spring bloomer with double pink flowers that look similar to cherry blossoms; compact glossy foliage turns dark purple in fall; 10-14 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 3 -----	12.99
* Brunnera 'Jack of Diamonds' (Siberian Bugloss) huge 9-10 inch leaves have a heavy silver overlay with wide, dark green veining; baby blue, forget-me-not type flowers are held in clusters above the foliage in spring; 14-16 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
Brunnera macrophylla 'Alexander's Great' (Siberian Bugloss) gigantic clumps carry bushel basket-sized leaves with silver flecking; makes a dramatic statement in the landscape; 28 inch spread; full to partial shade; Zone 4 ----	14.99
# Brunnera macrophylla 'Emerald Mist' (Siberian Bugloss) heavier silver bars connect to form a silver collar around the perimeter of the leaf; light silver-dusting over entire leaf; baby blue flowers; part shade; 12-15 inches; Zone 3	14.99
Brunnera macrophylla 'Variegata' (Siberian Bugloss) large green leaves boldly variegated with creamy-white color; needs shade and good moisture to prevent margins from scorching; blue flowers; 12 inches; Zone 3 -----	14.99

* Brunnera 'Queen of Hearts' (Siberian Bugloss) compared to 'Jack of Diamonds', this plant has a more pronounced silver overlay with narrower bands of dark green veining; baby blue forget-me-not type flowers in early spring; 16-18 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 3 -----	14.99
Buddleia 'Crown Jewels' (Butterfly Bush) magenta purple flowers sparkle like jewels against bright gold foliage in late summer through early fall; 3 1/2-4 feet tall; full sun; Zone 5-----	16.00
Buddleia 'Dark Dynasty' (Butterfly Bush) rich royal purple, fragrant flowers are produced in late summer and last for many weeks; forms a neat, rounded clump of dark green foliage; 3 feet; full sun; Zone 5 -----	16.00
Buddleia 'Little Nugget' (Butterfly Bush) magenta purple flowers are nicely set against brilliant gold foliage; flowers deepen to blue-purple with age; blooms mid summer to early fall; 30-36 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	16.00
# Buddleia Lo & Behold® 'Blue Chip Jr.' #2 (Butterfly Bush) a miniature butterfly bush! Grows to no more than 2 feet high and wide and blooms from early summer into autumn: full sun; Zone 5 -----	32.00
Buddleia Lo & Behold® 'Ice Chip' #2 (Dwarf Butterfly Bush) a profusion of pure white flowers against a backdrop of silvery foliage; blooms continuously; seedless; low, spreading plant; full sun; 2' tall and wide; Zone 5 -----	32.00

Buddleia 'Prince Charming' (Butterfly Bush) 10 inch long, bright cerise-pink flower spikes cover the upright, gumdrop-shaped habit; 42-48 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	16.00
# Buddleia 'Pugster Blue' #1 (Butterfly Bush) the Pugster series boasts huge, full sized flowers on a compact and sturdy frame; strong and thick stems will ensure better winter survival; true blue flowers; 2 feet tall x 2-3 feet wide; full sun; Zone 5-----	22.00

Campanula persicifolia 'Takion Blue' (Bellflower) a showy display of lavender blue, bell-shaped, upward and outward facing flowers in spring; compact habit; 16-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99
Campanula poscharskyana 'Blue Waterfall' (Bellflower) vigorous low-growing habit with sprays of starry lavender-blue flowers all summer; good groundcover; sun; 8-10 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99
# Carex caryophyllea 'Beatlemania' (Sedge) twist and shout over this mophead of green and gold; low grower at 6 inches, but up to 24 inches wide; best in moist, rich soil in light shade; Zone 5 -----	14.99
# Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance' (Variegated Sedge) compact tufts of 1/2 inch wide, dark green leaves with clear white borders; excellent low maintenance ground cover; moderate spread; 12 inches; Zone 5 -----	14.99
Centaurea 'Amethyst Dream' (Bachelor's Button) long blooming deep purple button-head flowers throughout the summer; 14-16 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
# Centaurea montana 'Amethyst in Snow' (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) large buds burst to reveal pure white trumpet-shaped petals; royal purple centers; fast grower; 24 inches; Zone 3-----	12.99
# Centaurea montana 'Blue' (Perennial Bachelor Button, Cornflower) blue fringed blooms; attracts butterflies; favorite cut flower; sun; 24 inches; Zone 3 -----	9.99

# Ceratostigma plumbaginoides (Plumbago, Leadwort) brilliant blue flowers from late summer to the first hard frost; bronzy-red foliage in fall; excellent groundcover for late season interest; 8-12 inches; best in partial shade; Zone 5-----	12.99
* Chrysanthemum 'Clara Curtis' (Hardy Garden Mum) single, pink daisy flowers with yellow centers bloom from late summer through fall; 14 inches; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
# Chrysanthemum Mammoth® 'Coral Daisy' #2 (Hardy Garden Mum) large coral lavender daisy-like blooms; heat tolerant; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
# Chrysanthemum Mammoth® 'Lavender Daisy' #2 (Hardy Garden Mum) lavender, daisy-shaped flowers bloom late summer to fall; requires no pinching, pruning, or deadheading; 2-3 feet; full sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99

Cimicifuga ramosa 'Hillside Black Beauty' (Black Snakeroot, Bugbane) striking, dark purplish-black foliage; fragrant, foot-long bottlebrush flowers are white with pink blush; best in shady, moist site; 4-7 feet; Zone 4 -----	16.99
* Clematis 'Stand By Me' (Bush Clematis) blue bell-shaped flowers appear late May to June with some rebloom in later summer; benefits from staking or neighboring plants for support; excellent for attracting pollinators; 34-38 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	19.99
# Convallaria majalis (Lily of the Valley) fragrant, white, bell-shaped flowers appear in May-June, followed by tiny, orange berries; good ground cover for shade; 6-8 inches; Zone 2-----	9.99
Convallaria majalis 'Bordeaux' (Lily of the Valley) large and prolific white blooms; flower stalks appear taller above the leaves; part shade; 6-8 inches; Zone 2 -----	9.99
Coreopsis Daybreak' (Tickseed) bicolor flowers have a prominent orange-red center with fringed, gold tips; blooms all season from early summer through early fall; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
Coreopsis 'Enchanted Eve' (Tickseed) butter yellow blooms with a soft red eye are incredibly long blooming; disease-free green foliage stays nice all season; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 5 -----	12.99
Coreopsis grandiflora 'Early Sunrise' (Tickseed) brilliant golden-yellow semi-double flowers all summer; All American Winner; sun; 18 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99
