Lobelia siphilitica (Blue Cardinal Flower) spikes of brilliant blue flowers on this wetland native attract butterflies and hummingbirds to your garden; likes moist conditions, even shallow water; full to partial sun; 30-36 inches; Zone 3-----	9.99

Grasses:

Panicum virgatum 'Totem Pole' (Switch Grass) forms a very upright column of steel blue foliage and powdery blue stems; golden seed panicles in early fall; a narrow base makes it ideal for small spaces; 6' tall x 2.5' wide; full sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
Sesleria autumnalis (Autumn Moor Grass) this cool season grass forms a low mound of bright green leaves; long, tan seedheads late in the season; great for mass planting or edging; 12-24 inches; full sun to partial shade; Zn 4--	14.99

Amazone [M] dark green margins flame inward to bold white centers; handles sun better than most white centered hostas; 20in tall (L)-----	18.00
Ben Vernooij [S] tetraploid sport of 'First Frost' with very thick leaves and a much wider margin; particularly stunning in spring due to blue leaves with a bright yellow margin; 13in tall x 25in wide (L) -----	18.00
Bulletproof [M] a tetraploid sport of the beloved 'Halcyon' with extremely thick blue leaves that hold their color late into the season when kept out of direct sunlight; 16in tall x 36in wide (L)-----	15.00
Color Festival [M] eye-catching tri-colored leaves have a distinct yellow streak between the white center and dark green margins; grow in some bright morning sun for best color; 15in tall x 25in wide (L)-----	15.00
Colored Hulk [M] thick, slightly cupped, upward growing foliage is lemon-lime green with dark green margins; reversed sport of 'Anne'; 16in tall x 20in wide (L)-----	18.00
** Firn Line [S] gorgeous blue with showy, very wide, white margins; a show stopper; 13in tall x 25in wide (L) -----	20.00
Forbidden Fruit [M] tetraploid sport of 'Orange Marmalade' with thicker leaves and wider blue-green margins; yellow-orange centers in spring turn nearly white late in the season; brightest if grown in some sun; 18in tall x 30in wide (L)-----	18.00
Glad Rags [M] very thick and extremely corrugated heart-shaped leaves; slightly cupped green leaves emerge with a chartreuse margin that brightens to gold then to ivory in late summer; 16in tall x 24in wide (L)-----	25.00
** Golden Meadows [M] sport of sieboldiana 'Elegans' with creamy white centers that age to muted gold; wide blue-green margins develop stitching with age; 18in tall x 35in wide (W)-----	20.00
Hide and Seek [Mini] sport of 'Hideout'; emerges pure white in the spring, turns shiny green in late spring, and melts out in the heat of summer like other white hostas; 5in tall x 12in wide (L)-----	35.00
Lemon Kiss [Mini] soft, round yellow leaves on bright red petioles produce a stunning contrast that will catch your eye in the miniature hosta garden; a cross between 'Smiley Face' and 'Beet Salad', this little gem glows; 6in tall x 14in wide (P)-----	35.00
Royal Crest [L] a hybrid of 'Royal Standard' with a more polished habit and thicker foliage; medium green, shiny foliage with large white, fragrant flowers; 28in tall x 50in wide (W)-----	18.00

** Sting [S] thick, dark green leaves with thin, variable, white centers; leaves are somewhat twisted and cupped; a reversed sport of 'Anne'; 13' tall x 24in wide (L)-----	18.00
Sun Worshiper [S] shiny, wavy bright yellow leaves on attractive red petioles hold color well through the season; best color with a little morning sun, but too much sun will bleach out the leaves; 10in tall x 22in wide (L)-----	18.00
Velvet Moon [M] a tetraploid sport of 'Abiqua Moonbeam' with thicker leaves and a much wider bright gold margin with green centers; will handle a lot of sun; 17in tall x 38in wide (L)-----	15.00
Volcano Island [M] tetraploid sport of 'Paradise Island' with thicker foliage and wider dark green margins; striking contrast of green leaves with yellow centers on red petioles; 14in tall x 30in wide (L)-----	18.00
** White Bikini [M] showy sport of 'Striptease'; dark green margins and narrow white centers; twisted leaf tips; vigorous grower; 22in tall x 45in wide (L)-----	18.00
X-cellent [S] small mound of slightly cupped blue-green foliage with a variable yellow center that flares into the leaf margin; leaf center emerges yellow and turns white in summer; 12in tall x 24in wide (L)-----	25.00

Allium 'Lavender Bubbles' (Ornamental Onion) dark purple flower globes in late summer above attractive blue-green foliage; blooms later than 'Millenium' and is a darker shade of purple; 12-14 inches; full to partial sun; Zn 4--	14.99
Amsonia 'Starstruck' (Blue Star) a very full habit of vibrant green leaves with lighter midribs and dark olive stems; blue star-shaped flowers cover the plant for many weeks in late spring and early summer; 20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
Anemone 'Spring Beauty' (Japanese Anemone) a pink spring-blooming variety; hot pink flowers are held above very upright foliage; flowers are sterile so they won't reseed like <i>A. sylvestris</i> ; 18 inches; partial shade; Zone 4-----	14.99
Aquilegia 'Earlybird Purple Blue' (Columbine) two-toned flowers are lavender-purple with blue centers; spring blooms occur just above low mounding foliage; 9-11 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Earlybird Purple Yellow' (Columbine) bicolor blooms are purple with yellow centers; spring blooms occur just above low mounding foliage; 9-11 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99

Aquilegia 'Earlybird Red Yellow' (Columbine) two-toned flowers are red with yellow centers; spring blooms occur just above low mounding foliage; 9-11 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Kirigami Deep Blue & White' (Columbine) upward-facing flowers of dark indigo blue and white shades on sturdy, upright stems bloom late spring to early summer; 22-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Kirigami Rose & Pink' (Columbine) upward-facing flowers of dark rose and light pink shades on sturdy, upright stems bloom late spring to early summer; 22-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Aquilegia 'Kirigami Yellow' (Columbine) upward-facing, light yellow flowers on sturdy, upright stems bloom late spring to early summer; 22-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Artemisia versicolor 'Sea Foam' (Wormwood) a vigorous, attractive groundcover with lacy, mounding foliage of silvery blue; clump forming and non-invasive; full to partial sun; 8-12 inches; Zone 4-----	14.99
Aster novae-angliae 'Grape Crush' (New England Aster) large, rich, dark purple flowers are densely packed above dark green foliage in early fall to midfall; 26-30 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
Baptisia 'Plum Rosy' (False Indigo) an elegant bicolor of mauve pink flowers that lighten to near white with age; blooms late spring to early summer; long lived and drought tolerant; 3.5-4' tall; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
Baptisia 'Violet Dusk' (False Indigo) Lavender violet flowers on a unique vase-like habit; although 3 feet wide, the base of the plant is relatively narrow, leaving space to plant underneath; 36-42 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 --	14.99
Bergenia 'Miss Piggy' (Pigsqueak) bright pink flowers top thick, dark green, glossy leaves in early spring; attractive mound of foliage after blooming; sun to shade, but partial shade is best; 16-18 inches; Zone 4-----	14.99
Brunnera 'Jack of Diamonds' (Siberian Bugloss) huge 9-10 inch leaves have a heavy silver overlay with wide, dark green veining; baby blue, forget-me-not type flowers are held in clusters above the foliage in spring; 14-16 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 3-----	14.99
Brunnera 'Queen of Hearts' (Siberian Bugloss) compared to 'Jack of Diamonds', this plant has a more pronounced silver overlay with narrower bands of dark green veining; baby blue forget-me-not type flowers in early spring; 16-18 inches; full to partial shade; Zone 3-----	14.99
Buddleia 'Lilac Cascade' (Butterfly Bush) huge, puffy panicles of pale lilac flowers cascade downward like a waterfall; 5-5.5'; full sun; Zone 5-----	16.99
Buddleia 'Princess Pink' (Butterfly Bush) 8 inch long, light appleblossom pink flower panicles appear in late summer above a round habit of dark green foliage; 5 feet; full sun; Zone 5-----	16.99
Campanula carpatica 'Delft Teacups' (Carpathian Bellflower) bicolor blue and white flowers bloom late spring to late summer; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Clematis 'Stand By Me' (Bush Clematis) blue bell-shaped flowers appear late May to June with some rebloom in later summer; benefits from staking or neighboring plants for support; excellent for attracting pollinators; 34-38 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	19.99
Corydalis 'Hillier Porcelain Blue' (Corydalis) striking blue, fragrant flowers bloom in spring and again in fall; a vigorous and tough grower; 10-12 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 5-----	14.99
Delphinium elatum 'Million Dollar Blue' (Hybrid Bee Delphinium) large spikes of semi-double to double true blue flowers bloom in early summer and again in early fall; 2.5-3'; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
Dianthus 'Constant Beauty Crush Pink' (Pinks) fragrant, semi-double pink flowers with a burgundy edge; blooms in late spring and again in fall with dead heading; 6-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Dianthus 'Cute as a Button' (Pinks) semi-double, bright pink flowers with a deep red eye and serrated edges; blooms in early summer; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Dianthus 'Everlast Burgundy Blush' (Pinks) very fragrant, double burgundy-red flowers with soft pink edge; extremely floriferous in spring and a continued bloom through summer; 10-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
Dianthus 'Everlast White + Eye' (Pinks) very fragrant, double white flowers with a pink eye provide color all summer; 10-12 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	12.99
Dianthus Fruit Punch® 'Cherry Vanilla' (Pinks) fully double, deep red flowers with a very light pink picotee edge appear in summer; shear after flowering to encourage rebloom in early fall; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4---	12.99
Dianthus 'Paint the Town Fancy' (Pinks) single, rosy fuchsia flowers with a red eye and serrated petals completely cover the plant at their peak in early summer; shearing after flowering will encourage rebloom in early fall; 8-10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Dianthus 'Paint the Town Red' (Pinks) single, deep magenta-red flowers with serrated petals completely cover the plant in peak bloom in early summer; shearing after flowering encourages rebloom in early fall; 6-8 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	12.99
Echinacea 'Canary Feathers' (Coneflower) large 5 inch, bright yellow flowers hold color better than most; well-branched, sturdy habit; 18-20 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99
Echinacea 'Delicious Candy' (Coneflower) a double coneflower with glowing fuchsia pink ray petals underneath large pink pom-poms; one of the first to flower; 18-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	14.99

Echinacea 'Frankly Scarlet' (Coneflower) 4 inch bright scarlet orange flowers lighten to coral orange as they age; 26-28 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea 'Orange You Awesome' (Coneflower) tangerine orange flowers are produced with dark cones and a faint reddish halo near the cones; 18-22 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea 'Prairie Splendor Compact Dark Rose' (Coneflower) blooms earlier and longer than any other Echinacea; deep rose blooms on a compact plant; 20-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea Sombrero® 'Granada Gold' (Coneflower) golden yellow flowers contrast nicely with very dark green foliage; 18-22 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea 'Tanager' (Coneflower) rich tangerine orange flowers with heavily overlapping petals and dark cones; 22-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea 'The Price is White' (Coneflower) 5 inch wide flowers with very wide, overlapping white petals with a green cone and yellow pollen; 20-22 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Echinacea 'Yellow My Darling' (Coneflower) rich yellow flowers contrast beautifully with its dark green leaves; flowers age to an attractive creamy yellow; 18-24 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Filipendula 'Red Umbrellas' (Meadow Sweet) maple-shaped green leaves with heavy red veining; long lasting pink plumes in summer; partial shade, but will tolerate more sun with adequate moisture; 24-30 inches; Zone 3 ----	12.99
Gaillardia aristata 'Spintop Copper Sun' (Blanket Flower) copper-orange flowers with yellow tips sit above compact clumps of green foliage; blooms late spring to fall; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Gaillardia aristata 'Spintop Red Starburst' (Blanket Flower) bright yellow flowers with a large red eye sit above compact clumps of green foliage; blooms late spring to fall; 8-12 inches; full sun; Zone 4-----	9.99
Geum 'Pretticoats Peach' (Avens) profuse, ruffled, peach and yellow semi-double flowers bloom in spring and rebloom throughout the summer; compact, clumping green foliage; 10 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 4 -----	12.99
Geum 'Tempo Orange' (Avens) single and double cream to peach to orange blooms are enjoyed by pollinators for months; foliage grows to 9 inches with flowers reaching 15 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 5-----	16.99
Geum 'Tempo Rose' (Avens) dark, rose-pink flowers on dark stems are enjoyed by pollinators for months; foliage grows to 8 inches with flowers reaching 21 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 5 -----	16.99
Helenium 'Salud Yellow' (Sneezeweed) tons of yellow daisy flowers from summer through fall over compact foliage; great for late season color; 14-16 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	12.99
Heliopsis 'Bleeding Hearts' (False Sunflower) intense orange red flowers mature to golden orange with red centers; deep green leaves with bronze highlights and black flower stems; 36-40 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	14.99
Helleborus Honeymoon 'French Kiss' (Lenten Rose) single white flowers infused with raspberry pink veins and edges; blooms for six weeks or more beginning in late winter; 18-24 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 4 -----	14.99
Helleborus 'Ice N' Roses Red' (Lenten Rose) outward-facing deep red flowers in early spring over glossy, dark green foliage; 15-18 inches; partial sun to shade; Zone 5 -----	19.99
Hibiscus 'Summer Carnival' #3 (Rose Mallow) 7 inch magenta pink flowers cover the upright, rounded habit; variegated foliage has narrow cream margins with a hint of blush at the edges; 4-4.5 feet; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	28.00
Hibiscus Summerific® 'Evening Rose' #3 (Rose Mallow) 8 inch hot-pink puckered flowers cover the round, dense habit of near-black foliage; 4 feet tall; full to partial sun; Zone 4-----	28.00

Iris g. 'Bluebird Wine' (Tall Bearded Iris) pale blue standards infused with red violet at the midrib; red violet falls with a white beard tipped yellow; blooms mid to late spring; 32 inches; full sun; Zone 3-----	9.99
Iris g. 'Frappe' (Tall Bearded Iris) pale pinkish white standards with very pale pink falls and orange tangerine beards; blooms mid to late spring; 34 inches; full sun; Zone 3 -----	9.99

Lilium asiatic 'Spring Combo' (Asiatic Lily) a combo of pink, white and purple lilies; 14-16 inches; full to partial sun; Zone 3-----	14.99

TREES IN LINER POTS

All of these plants are great to use in troughs and fairy gardens. Trim them back if they start to get too large, or pop them out and let them grow to full size elsewhere in your gardens.

Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Just Dandy' (Dwarf Hinoki Cypress) exquisite, tight foliage, but a faster grower than expected; forms a cute beach ball sized globe; 1.5' x 2'; part shade; Zone 5 -----	19.00
Ilex crenata 'Sky Pencil' (Upright Holly) tall, slender, female holly with a distinctive, upright habit; dark green, glossy leaves are small and rounded; part shade; garden size 10' tall, 3' wide; Zone 5 -----	19.00

Ilex x 'Rock Garden' (Holly) dwarf, spreading, hybrid evergreen holly, growing 1' tall and 2' wide over 15 years; glossy, deep green leaves; part shade; Zone 5 ----- 19.00

Vines:

- Clematis Acropolis**[®] glowing magenta-pink flowers with creamy centers with a deeper pink stripe on each petal; ideal for a small garden, deck garden or patio; blooms May to October; 3-4'; Zone 4; pruning group 3 ----- 22.00
- Clematis Olympia**[®] single and sometimes semi-double blue blooms with yellow anthers; blooms late spring to late summer and again in fall; 3-5 feet tall; full sun; Zone 4; pruning group 3 ----- 22.00
- Clematis Paulie**[®] a compact clematis with masses of purple flowers that have a maroon bar on each petal; blooms June-September; grows 3-5 feet tall; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 2 ----- 22.00
- Clematis 'Piilu'** a heavy bloomer with double or semi-double light pink flowers with rose bars and full centers of ruffled petals; blooms late spring through late summer and again in fall; 4-6' tall; full sun; Zone 4; pruning group 2-- 22.00
- Clematis Tranquillite**[®] glowing white flowers with a subtle hint of blue bloom late spring to late summer; grows 4-5' tall; ideal in a more shaded area such as a north facing wall; Zone 4; pruning group 3 ----- 22.00
- Clematis Vicki**[®] vivid pink blooms with darker magenta bars bloom throughout the summer; grows 3-4' tall; full to partial sun; Zone 4; pruning group 3----- 34.00
